## **Overview**

The *IA Industry Indicators: Jobs* (*3i Jobs*) report presents monthly insights on the U.S. job market using data from national and internet-based resources. It track trends in the traditional and freelance job markets and presents unique information on Hiring, Openings, and Online Income.

#### Traditional Job Openings<sup>1</sup>


Online postings and National Unemployment suggest a shift from PT positions to more FT work


