Traditional Job Openings¹


Online postings saw a further decline in FT positions, continuing from last month

Internet Work Resources

- Traditional job searches, applications, and hirings through the internet saw their first declines since the debut of IA's survey in May 2019
- Average income earned through the internet reduced by about a third over last month
