

## 3i US Jobs - October 2020

## **Overview**

The *IA Industry Indicators: Jobs* (*3i Jobs*) report presents monthly insights on the U.S. job market using data from national and internet-based resources. It tracks trends in the traditional and freelance job markets and presents unique information on Hiring, Openings, and Online Income.

## Traditional Job Openings<sup>1</sup>


- Online full-time (FT) and part-time (PT) postings continued to steadily increase by 4.5 percent and 7.8 percent, respectively, month-over-month in September 2020.
- Although online FT postings decreased by 7.6 percent year-over-year, PT postings increased by 23.1 percent year-over-year in September 2020.

## **Internet Work Resources**

- In September 2020, use of the internet to earn income decreased by 2.3 percent month-over-month, and by 1.3 percent year-over-year.
- American's use of the internet to search, apply, and get hired for a job further declined by 0.01 percent, 2.0 percent, and 2.0 percent respectively month-over-month in September 2020.
